Applicants must be an Australian registered business owner (this includes partnerships, franchises and companies), and have an ABN. They must reside and operate their business in the region of South East SA and Western Victoria. Past recipients of the WIBRD Scholarships are not eligible to enter again.

JUDGING

Judging will take place prior to February the 10th February, 2019. The winners of the scholarships will be announced at the WIBRD Launch on February the 15th February, 2019. The Judging Panel will have the final decision and no correspondence will be entered into.

CRITERIA

Applicants are required to answer questions regarding their business at the following www.wibrd.org.au/scholarship. Please include a current profile photo, business logo and business plan (if applicable) with your submission.

Business Booster Scholarship

This scholarship will be assessed on the businesses need for assistance at its current stage in the business life cycle. This will be determined by assessing the businesses:

Entrepreneur Scholarship

This scholarship will be assessed on the individual's ability to prove their entrepreneurial potential. This will be determined by assessing the applicants:

- Capacity and willingness to develop a product and/or service
- Ability to organise and manage a business venture
- Courage to take the risk to turn the concept into reality
- Ability to bring to the market a viable product and/or service that people want or need 0
